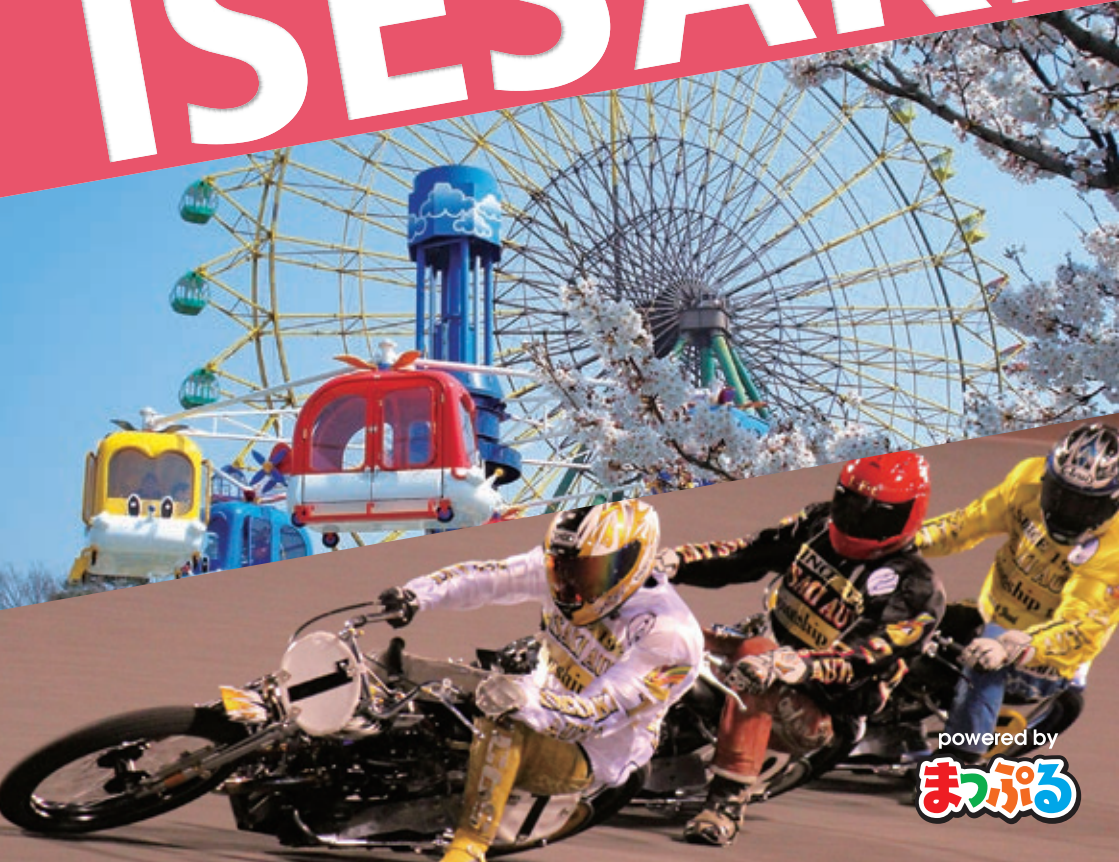

All about Iseaki



Iseaki has long thrived thanks to the area's silkworm-raising industry, boasting a history of more than 1,200 years as a textile town. Textiles developed as the area's main industry, such that Iseaki meisen silks became known around the nation.

Recommended tourist spots in Iseaki



Iseaki Meiji-Kan

いせさき明治館 (Former clinic)
Built in 1912, this building features numerous examples of European-style architecture. Iseaki meisen silks are on exhibit at all times.

Koizumi-Inari Jinja Shrine

小泉稲荷神社
More than 200 torii gates made as offerings to the shrine decorate the grounds in front. At 22.17 meters, the large gate is the tallest in the prefecture.



Iseaki Auto Race

伊勢崎オートレース
Auto racing is a government-controlled competitive sport, like horse-racing, bicycle-racing, and boat racing. Reaching speeds of 150 kilometers per hour, the cars are truly exhilarating to watch.



World Cultural Heritage

Tomioka Silk Mill and Related Sites Tajima Yahei Sericulture Farm

田島弥平旧宅

The former Tajima Yahei residence, built by Tajima himself in 1863, was not only Tajima's home but also a silkworm nursery. Tajima Yahei is known for perfecting Seiryoku, a system of silkworm culture technologies to produce quality silkworm eggs.

A symbol of the amusement park, this ferris wheel stands 65 meters high for an incredible panoramic view!

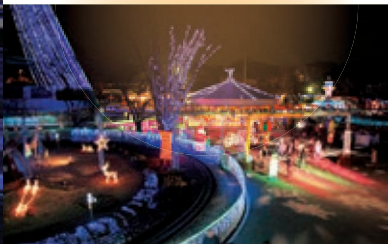


Roller coaster

"KARA": savory flavor with curry powder

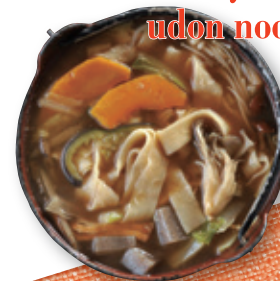
